The EXCEED International Skills Exhibition

The EXCEED Skills Exhibition is an international contest where applicants can present to regional, national and international stakeholders co-created innovative solutions/projects, ("masterpieces") to boost the green and digital transformations of Advanced Manufacturing. These co-created solutions can also specifically foresee that digital technologies support and boost the greening of processes and products, according to the eco-digital innovation paradigm underpinning the EXCEED project.

Interested applicants are invited to cooperate in groups to create their solutions/masterworks to be shared and presented to the wide public during the final Online international event, which will take place on the 16th of April 2026, from 14.00 to 17.30 CET, in its first edition.

Participants, to develop/prepare their masterpieces, can cooperate locally, or internationally, (e.g., through international mobility schemes, virtual or physical), joining forces with other groups of students from VET Schools, VET Centres and Universities. Masterpieces can be developed within curricular or extracurricular activities. The process through which each group of candidates will prepare the work to be candidated, is up to participants and supervisors.



EXCEED Exhibition 2026 - the challenge

The EXCEED International Skills Exhibition is a challenge-based contest. Its first edition, aims at launching to all participants a challenge inspired by the *FAB CITY* concept:

"A Fab City is a locally productive, globally connected, self-sufficient city. Fab Labs (Fabrication Laboratories) and makerspaces offer opportunities for people to make and produce what they need for themselves, and to bring back to citizens the skills and knowledge needed to make things".

The Challenge all participants have to answer, by creating their own masterpieces is the following:

"Zero Waste communities: What is the contribution of Advanced Manufacturing?"

In the framework of the contest, "waste" is not only "scrap", but also any exceeding energy consumption, or any overuse of raw materials and natural resources, or any malfunctioning of plants and machines, etc.

Each group of participants, depending on its field of education and expertise, can find a diversified answer to the challenge, applying creativity, system thinking, and technical skills.

Expression of Interest

Who can participate:

The EXCEED Exhibition is open to any VET School/VET centre/University interested in participating in the overall contest.

Prior target groups are students/trainees aged >17, attending a post-secondary VET programme or attending the last year/s of the upper secondary school, or, attending the University, (e.g., Professional bachelor's degrees, etc.).

Please, be aware the focus of the Exhibition will be on eco-digital innovation in Advanced Manufacturing!

How to:

The application process is divided into two stages.

Ensure that all required documents are submitted before the deadline — only complete applications will be considered valid.





The application process is divided into two stages. Read the instructions carefully and ensure that all required documents are submitted before the deadline. Only fully completed applications will be considered valid.

The Call is open from 01/12/2025 to 28/02/2026.

FIRST STEP:

Pre-Application (Expression of Interest)

Objective:

To officially register the participation of the educational institution and its teams, and to enable the preparation of the project proposal.

What to Submit:

At this stage, each participating **School**, **VET Centre**, **or University** is requested to provide through the following <u>Microsoft Form</u> [https://forms.office.com/e/z0fSfq5emZ]:

- 1. **Basic institutional information**, including:
 - Name and address of the institution;
 - Name and contact details of the institutional coordinator or responsible person;
 - Indication of the courses or departments involved;
 - Estimated number of students/trainees participating.
- 2. **Upload a signed confirmation letter** (institutional endorsement form), prepared on the **official letterhead** of the organisation and signed by a **legal representative or delegated authority**.
 - The letter formally confirms the intention of the institution to participate in the EXCEED Exhibition and to support one or more student groups in developing and submitting their project(s).
 - If multiple groups or courses from the same institution intend to participate, one consolidated letter is sufficient.

Once this stage is completed, your participation will be formally registered.

SECOND STEP:

Submission of the works

Objective: To submit the detailed description and project developed related materials by the registered group(s).





Procedure:

Registered institutions will receive a confirmation email with detailed instructions how to upload their project proposals, at the https://exceed-cove.eu/.

During the following step the following materials should be uploaded:

- The project presentation prepared using the official EXCEED Skills Exhibition template, available on the <u>Exceed website</u>;
- One video introducing the masterpiece: the video can be realized with a smartphone, or any device the group prefers, or have at disposal. No professional recording is required. MP4 format is recommended.

Once <u>both steps are completed</u> participants will receive an email from the EXCEED Partnership, confirming their participation, together with social media kit, that might be used for the promotion of the participation.

USE AND PUBLICATION OF MATERIALS

By submitting their project materials — including videos, presentations, images, and related documentation — participants acknowledge and grant authorisation to the EXCEED partnership for the use, publication, and dissemination of such materials within the framework of the project's communication, dissemination, and educational activities.

a) Purpose of the Authorisation

The materials submitted within the EXCEED International Skills Exhibition may be used by the EXCEED partnership and its authorised representatives exclusively for:

- Public dissemination and promotion of the EXCEED project and its results;
 Educational and training activities, including online courses, workshops, or events linked to the project's objectives;
- Institutional communication, such as articles, newsletters, and project reports;
- Public exhibitions, conferences, and events organised under the EXCEED framework or related EU initiatives.

All uses will serve the overarching purpose of sharing knowledge, highlighting participants' achievements, and promoting innovation in vocational education and training in line with the project's goals.

b) Publication Channels





Submitted materials may be published through the following channels:

- The official EXCEED <u>project website</u> and related digital platforms (<u>LinkedIn</u>, Facebook, YouTube);
- The social media pages or online accounts managed by the EXCEED consortium and its partners;
- Press releases, digital newsletters, or multimedia publications linked to EXCEED communication actions:
- Public EU project repositories or educational databases, if relevant to dissemination obligations.

Where possible, due credit will be given to the authors, teams, and institutions involved, in accordance with the visibility and communication standards of the project.

Personal data and information provided in the application form will be used solely for the purpose of conducting a thorough and effective evaluation of applicants

Submission of an application constitutes full, complete, and unreserved acceptance of these data protection terms.
